Policy on Classified Ads

Adopted November 2003

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The NWMAF will accept Classified Ads. Categories include, but are not limited to: merchandise, services, rentals, items wanted, congratulations, job openings, volunteer opportunities. The contents should be appropriate to NWMAF standards, and NWMAF maintains the right to edit or refuse any ad. No "personal ads" will be accepted.

Draft Classified Ad Procedures:

Classified Ads may be printed in the NWMAF newsletter with a 30-word maximum for \$10 for a one-time publication. Current categories are: merchandise, services, rentals, items wanted, congratulations, job openings, and volunteer opportunities, but other categories can be added as the Board and Editor deem appropriate or necessary. At a later time, NWMAF should pursue posting classified ads on its website, when we are more able to regularly update the site.

Background:

From time to time, material that is distributed by NWMAF to its members through newsletters may be deemed appropriate for posting on the organization's website or for use in outreach and external publications, with full credit to the author, artist, or photographer. Similarly, material posted on the organization's website may be suitable for publication in the NWMAF newsletter or for use in outreach and external publications, with full credit to the author, artist, or photographer.

NWMAF wishes to maintain the ability to distribute material submitted to it in a manner that will promote NWMAF while protecting those who prefer restricted distribution or privacy. NWMAF does not presently have a "members only" section of its website with access restricted to members.
